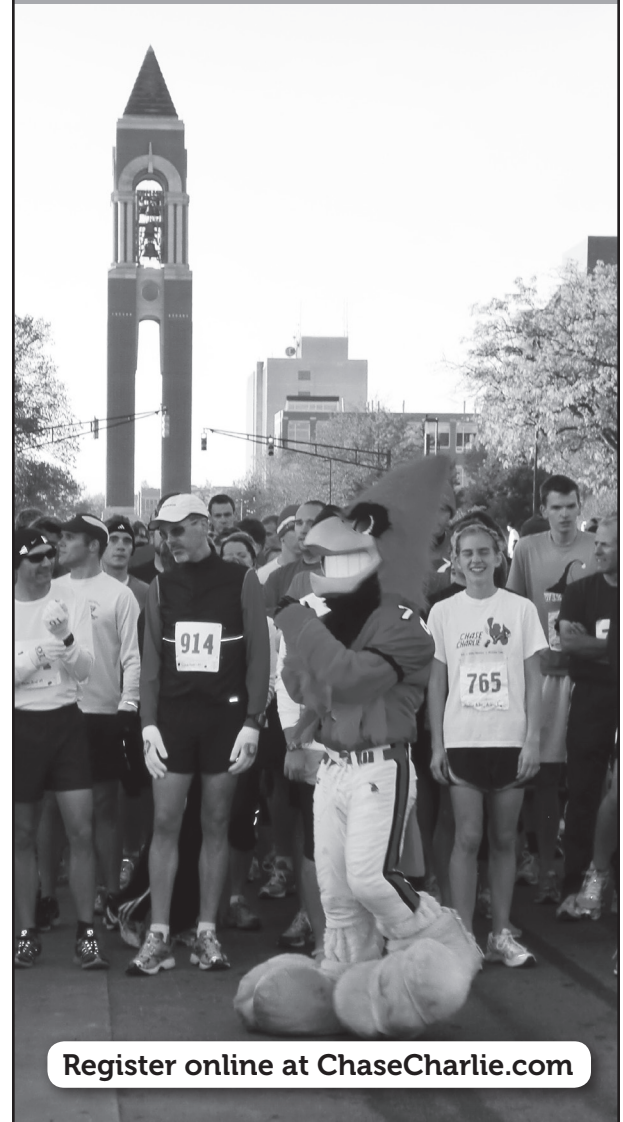

# CHASE CHARLIE



## 5K Run | Walk | Roll - Presented by Army ROTC (September 24th, 9:00 a.m.)

The 5K is a race for all ages open to runners, walkers, wheelchairs, and strollers (no bicycles). The 5K (3.1 mile) course begins at the Alumni Center, strolls through campus, and ends on the field at Scheumann Stadium. A map and specific directions will be provided on race day. Light refreshments and awards will be distributed after the race at the Picnic Shelter in Benadum Woods (north side Scheumann Stadium).

Chip timing will be used to score the 5K race. All runners must attach the Chip as instructed in order to be timed and eligible for any awards. Awards will be distributed to the top racers in the following male and female divisions: 18 & younger, 19-24, 25-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60 & up, and wheelchair.

All pre-registrants (deadline September 18th) are guaranteed a t-shirt. The first 300 registrants will receive a ticket to the Ball State vs. Army football game. Day-of registrants will receive t-shirts and game tickets on a first come, first served basis.

Race day check-in for 5K participants begins at 7 a.m. and ends at 8:45 a.m. inside the Alumni Center. Parking is available in the north end of the gravel lot on the northwest side of Scheumann Stadium (enter off Bethel). All cars must be removed from this lot no later than 11:00 a.m. Cars may be parked for the day in the lot adjacent to Cardinal Creek Tennis Courts (free) or in the lot next to the baseball field (\$5).

## Kiddie 100 - Presented by BSU Athletics (September 24th, Halftime of BSU football game)

The Kiddie 100 is a fun run for children 8 and under who will chase the BSU mascot, Charlie Cardinal, across the football field. This race will take place during halftime of the football game. Parents should take their child to the North End Zone (grassy hill) with 5 minutes remaining in the first half. The race starts at the north goal line and finishes at the south goal (scoreboard). Parents can pick up their child at the south end of the stadium.

All pre-registrants (deadline September 18th) are guaranteed a t-shirt. The first 300 registrants will

receive a ticket to the Ball State vs. Army football game. Day-of registrants will receive t-shirts and game tickets on a first come, first served basis.

Race day check-in for Kiddie 100 participants will be located on the southwest side of Scheumann Stadium (Gate 4) beginning at Noon and ending at 2:45 p.m. Parking is available in the lot adjacent to Cardinal Creek Tennis Courts (free) or the lot next to the baseball field (\$5).

## Mile Mania - Presented by YMCA of Muncie (October 1st, 9:00 a.m.)

The Mile Mania is a race for children 13 and younger. Racers will run one mile through the Briner Sports Complex then finish on the field at Scheumann Stadium. Parents of younger participants may run/walk the course with their child at no cost. All finishers will receive a ribbon, and the top 10 boys and girls will receive special awards. A course map will be provided on race day.

All participants are invited to Charlie's Fun Zone, an inflatable games village courtesy of the YMCA of Muncie, located in Benadum Woods north of Scheumann stadium after the race.

All pre-registrants (deadline September 25th) are guaranteed a t-shirt, and day-of registrants will receive shirts on a first come, first served basis. Football tickets are not associated with this event.

Race day check-in for Mile Mania participants will be located in Scheumann Stadium beginning at 7:30 a.m. and ending at 8:45 a.m. Free parking will be available in the gravel lot on the northwest side of Scheumann Stadium (enter off Bethel).

A special trophy will be awarded by Charlie Cardinal to the school with the greatest number of registrations for the Mile Mania. Cowan Elementary School has won this award the past two years.
